On March 19, at a press conference on the steps of New York City Hall, POTS joined United Way of NYC and the Fund for the City of New York in the launch the 2024 True Cost of Living Policy Brief.

The Brief builds on data from the True Cost of Living Report showing that 50% of New York City families cannot meet all of their basic needs. With contributions from POTS and a wide range of peer organizations, the Brief provides actionable suggestions to create pathways for a more affordable New York City for all.

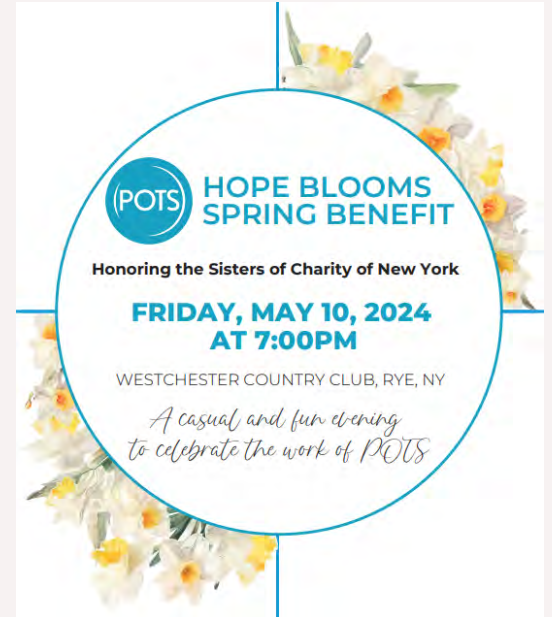


Hope Blooms Spring Benefit - May 10.
